The Korean Church of Cornell University Vision Trip team (Vision team) led by Rev. Hong—Pyo Ha and 12 members, visited Ethiopia from January 18th to 24th. Vision Team hosted program in Showa—Robit region, about 5 hour drive from Addis Ababa, to provide free medical care in a local public health center building with 9 MCM medical staff including Dr. Won—hee Kang, on January 22nd and 23th. Vision Team

consists of mainly young university students and many are hoping to become future medical missionaries. They had a good opportunity to learn the life of medical missionary by participating in the Mobile Clinic with Drs. Kuhn Hong, Dong-Su Shin and Won-hee Kang. Vision Team and MCM Mobile Clinic team provided medical service to more than 600 patients where the local public health center couldn't provide to the residents of the village.

From January 31st to February 2nd, Seoul Asan Hospital's 12 members medical team led by Prof. Young—shin Ra visited Ziway province of Ethiopia to have joint mobile clinic with MCM. The first day of the clinic was held at the Abosa Kale Hiwot Church, which located in a desolate area without any water or electricity. Although the clinic was carried in quite harsh situation with blowing dusty wind, the joint MCM and Asan Hospital medical team continued mobile clinic by encouraging and inspiring each other. They gave medical treatment for more than 700 patients on the first day including several minor surgical procedures. The next day, they opened a mobile clinic in a compound of a Mekane Yesus Church in Ziway province and took care of another 400 patients. Asan Hospital medical team members said that they have been challenged, inspired and richly blessed through their involvement in this volunteer mobile clinic. Asan Hospital team visited a primary school and orphanage to distribute school supplies, clothes, and sporting goods on February 3rd. They took three days off to tour the brighter side of Ethiopia and relax before going back to Korea.



Experiencing the Ethiopian National Holiday, Timkat



January 20th was the major religious holiday in Ethiopia, Timkat which means "baptism" in Amharic. This day is to celebrate the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist in the River Jordan. Each year, special celebration of

Timkat is being held in the John Mead Square at Sidist Killo region of Addis Ababa. Pastor Yoon-Ki Kim and many volunteers in the MCM received special invitation passes from the Ethiopian Orthodox Church allowing us to have closer look at the entire process. The Archbishop and the Orthodox priests read the scripture repeatedly about the baptism of Jesus in the John Mead Square. Then the Archbishop and the Orthodox priests walked around the pool blessing with the holy water. After the ceremony, they sprinkled the holy water (connected to the regular tap water) and blessed the thousands of participants gathered around the pool for this event. Through attending this special event of Timkat, volunteers were able to appreciate a part of the Ethiopian culture and history, deeply rooted in Christian faith.
